What's an integration?

An integration is simply a connection between two platforms, allowing information to flow from one system to another.

With MyPost Business, you can integrate your account with one of our eCommerce partners. Then you can automate the management and fulfillment of online orders, saving you time and money.

In this guide, you'll find an overview of the three different types of eCommerce partners (shipping platforms, eCommerce platforms and marketplaces like eBay), as well as instructions on how to integrate your MyPost Business account depending on which eCommerce partner you choose.



Benefits of an integration with one of our eCommerce partners

Save time

Integrating with an eCommerce partner allows you to automate your shipping workflows. For example, import your online orders and print all your shipping labels at once.



See more delivery options

Some eCommerce partners will show you all the different service partners for each order, and how much they cost. So you can choose the one that suits you.



Gain business insights

Some eCommerce partners will provide you with analytics to help with operational efficiency, shipping cost analysis and customer insights.



Depending on which eCommerce partner you choose, you can:



Access other Australia Post delivery services like Parcel Contract, eParcel and StarTrack



Automatically send SMS & email notifications to your customers



Generate packing slips, manifests and customs documentation



Allocate orders to multiple shipping services



Auto-correct invalid addresses



Manage the returns process



Create branded tracking pages

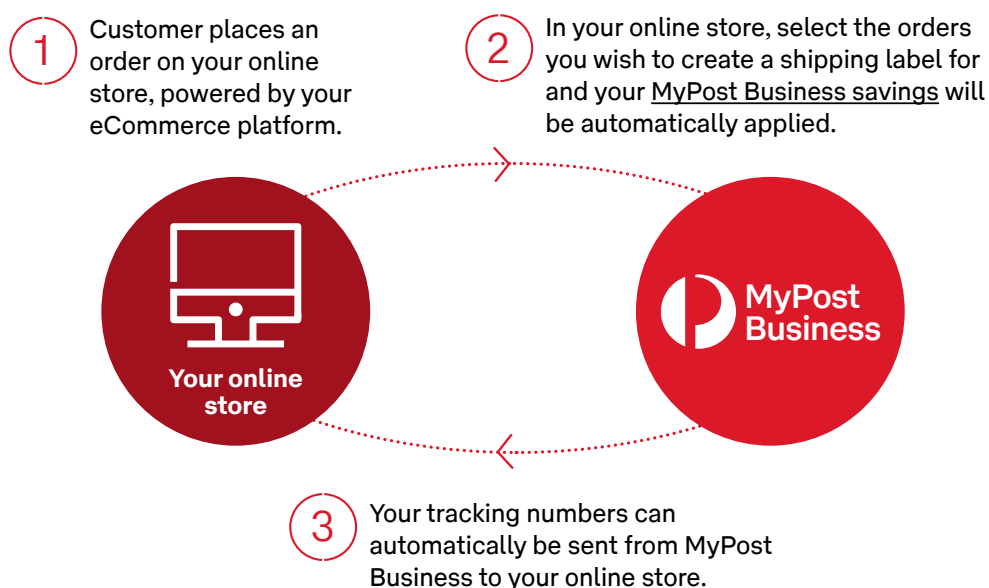


How to automate your MyPost Business shipping labels

Option 1: Automatically create your shipping labels in an eCommerce platform

Another way to automatically create shipping labels is to connect your MyPost Business account with the eCommerce platform that powers your online store. This will allow you to create and pay for labels in your online store and still access your MyPost Business savings as you would normally.

To get started

- 1** Connect your eCommerce Platform with your MyPost Business account by following the instructions in the [integration guide](#).
- 2** Configure your MyPost Business account with your online store using the instructions provided by the eCommerce platform.

Option 2: Automatically create your shipping labels by importing your orders from eBay

If you have your online store on eBay, you can automatically send your orders straight to your MyPost Business account.

You can then use the MyPost Business online platform to print all your shipping labels at once.



Tip: If you find it easier, you can also bulk import your eBay orders into MyPost Business using a CSV file.

To get started

- 1 Integrate your eBay store with your MyPost Business account so you can import all your orders. This should only take about 10 minutes.



Option 3: Automatically create your shipping labels in a shipping platform

One way you can automate shipping label creation is through a shipping platform, which will connect your online store to your MyPost Business account. Some shipping platforms will also show you all the available shipping options for each of your orders so you can choose the best service partner for each parcel.

How integrating a shipping platform works



To get started

- 1** Choose a shipping platform that integrates with both your online store and MyPost Business from the list on the following page.
- 2** Integrate your shipping platform with your MyPost Business account so you still receive all the savings you've earned. This only takes about 10 minutes. **Download the integration guide** or watch this **video**.
- 3** Integrate your shipping platform with your online store. Your shipping platform will give you instructions on how to do this.



Tip: Before choosing a shipping platform, look at whether it integrates with your other digital platforms. eg. your accounting or inventory management software. Also consider any more advanced features you may need, which you can check with the shipping platform.
